COURSE DESCRIPTION

Latin II is designed to follow the chapters in Latin I. Latin II will bring students to a point where they can read the Latin of classical authors with confidence. It will enhance general language learning techniques, including facility with English. It will include more study into the culture of the Romans, its historic significance, and its contemporary relevance.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the completion of Latin II students will have a better understanding of English terms and their Latin derivatives. New Latin grammatical items will be introduced that will be compared to English grammar. New cultural material will be studied and students will look deeper into the art of Rome. This course will encourage movement from the concrete to the abstract because the textbook puts reading and comprehension before grammatical generalizations and analysis.

Textbook – Ecce Romani II CD – Audio (for correct pronunciation of Latin terms and passages)

ASSIGNMENTS, QUIZZES, AND TESTS

Tests will be given for each chapter. Some tests may cover more than one chapter.

Homework Assignments (Chapter Assignments, Directives, and Reviews) and quizzes together for each chapter will count 40% of the total grade. Test will make up 60% of the total grade. Special projects will be counted the same as a test grade. There will be no extra credit assignments.
